

- ▶ **Use your phone for God's glory**—worship songs, Scripture, and good content, not evil music or wrong images.
- ▶ **Build your own prayer life** and don't depend only on a pastor's prayers.
- ▶ **Be specific in prayer** about your needs, struggles, and failures.
- ▶ **Find true fulfilment in Jesus**, not temporary comfort from people.
- ▶ **Invite Jesus daily** into your heart for change, deliverance, and miracles.
- ▶ **Fix your eyes on Jesus**, not on the storms around you.
- ▶ **Live for God's purpose**, not controlled by caste, religion, systems, fear, or work pressure.
- ▶ **Expect God to move today**—believe for divine encounters and miracles.
- ▶ **Forgive others as God forgives you**—unforgiveness opens doors to the enemy, so ask God for grace to forgive.
- ▶ **Testimony of transformation:** Dr. Jayapaul's father, once an alcoholic and suicidal man, was changed in one night of prayer by Jesus. His repentance was real—he **burned idols and addictions**, confessed hidden sin, returned **bribe money and gold**, and lived **40 years in purity and blessing**.
- ▶ **A life of endurance:** Even after decades of ministry, Dr. Jayapaul continues preaching with fire, reaching nations and many languages.
- ▶ **Marriage healing is God's design:** transparency, honor, and unity protect love and strengthen homes.

The children joyfully displayed their God-given talents through songs, memory verses, and inspiring presentations. Grace and peace to you. This week we're focusing on learning the lifestyle of Jesus—not only in words, but in daily choices.

Scripture of the Week: "Whoever wants to be My disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow Me." — Luke 9:23.

Reflection: Following Jesus is not a one-time decision—it's a daily surrender.

This Week's Practice: The Lifestyle of Forgiveness

Choose one person you need to forgive. Pray for them by name for 5 minutes each day. Ask God to soften your heart and free you from bitterness.

Jesus forgave when it wasn't deserved. Forgiveness is not pretending the pain didn't happen—it's releasing the right to revenge and trusting God with justice. When we forgive, we become more like Christ, and our hearts become a home for His peace.

Events that happened in 3rd week of Jan'26 to seek the fruit of the Word sown in your daily prayers (11th to 17th Jan'26):

- **Sunday Worship on 11th Jan'26** -1st session Hindi/Eng – Short msg and Telugu only
-2nd session Tamil/Eng/Telugu.

Here are few main points discussed:

- Boldly declare your identity as a child of Jesus when questioned in your home, workplace, and community, becoming an active witness without shame,
- Practice continuous prayer during all daily activities—working, traveling, bus/car rides, meetings—making prayer the top priority until reaching each destination,
- King Hezekiah's story is a warning that even a good and faithful person can still fall. After ruling well for many years, praying and receiving 15 more years of life, and being saved in a miracle from the Assyrians, he later became proud. He showed all his wealth to visitors from Babylon, and because of that, God said Babylon would one day take everything and even take his descendants away. It shows that past faithfulness and past miracles don't excuse present pride, sin, or compromise.
- **Wednesday Fasting Prayer- 14th Jan'26** — As many of our church members travelled to Vijayawada for the next day's session, we gathered for our regular time of worship and prayer, lifting up one another's burdens before the Lord and seeking His grace and guidance.

- **Feed on God's Word daily:** Stay strong by receiving the Word consistently through daily spiritual teachings and prayer.
